Drop-off & Pick-up

Wollaton Holiday Club runs from 8am-6pm every week day

Please accompany your child onto the site where you will be required to sign them in with a member of the team. If your child has any medication with them please let us know at this point. If you are travelling by bus, the nearest bus stop is Eton Grove (Stop WO02). If your child has any additional needs, please phone Cath Shotton on **07787 178 269** to make sure we meet your needs.

Arriving at Wollaton Holiday Club

There will be staff on site from 8am to make sure everyone is ready for the day's activities. Play Leaders will welcome the children, introduce them to the group and show them around the site. We will show children where they can keep their belongings and also explain how we'll be moving around throughout the day. Please encourage your children to make sure they ask lots of questions if they don't understand anything!

Leaving Wollaton Holiday Club

We won't let any child leave without a designated adult. If someone else is picking up your child from site, please make sure:

- a) You have filled out a designated person for pick up form. This was on the booking form but please ring 0115 711 7006 if you are unsure.
- b) You let the Play Leader know on the day.
- c) The designated adult has your collection password.
- d) Your child knows who is going to be picking them up.

If you would like you older children to make their way to and from the club by themselves, we'll need your written permission before your booked days/week begins. You can send this to **childcare@nottsymca.org** and we'll let you know that we have received it. When children leave by themselves, we will text you to let you know.

Parent/Carer pick up Pick up until 18:00

If you are going to be late please let us know on: **07398 388 073**. We charge £5 followed by £5 for every 5 minutes that you are late. We discourage appointments and early collection as it disrupts the day for both your child and other children at the site.

Keeping healthy & safe

The health and safety of every child is our primary concern at all times. By following our guidelines on medication and illness you can help keep our clubs safe for everyone.

Medical authorisation

We need your permission before we can administer your child with any medication. This must have been prescribed by their doctor, dentist or nurse. You will need to complete a medication administration form on the first day your child attends the club.

We can only administer medication if it is in its original container with the following information:

- Child's name
- Date of prescription
- Prescription's expiry date
- Name of pharmacist
- Correct dosage instruction

Illness, accidents and emergencies

Please don't bring your child to Wollaton Holiday Club if they are not feeling well. Call us to let us know on 07398 388 073

In the event of an accident or sudden illness, the club staff are equipped with the training and supplies to administer first aid. If the situation warrants further attention, emergency services will be contacted. You will be notified, by phone, if any injury or illness requires medical attention or if your child needs to be picked up. If we can't contact you, the emergency contact person that you have indicated will be notified.

COVID-19

We adhere closely to the latest government guidelines at all times. Our team support children to stay safe, with regular cleaning and handwashing.

Please do not bring your child if they are displaying symptoms of COVID-19.

Activities



At our club, we provide children with a huge variety of physical games, artistic projects and experiential learning to encourage growth, confidence building and cognitive development. We make sure all children have a brilliant time with us and we always welcome feedback from children and families to further improve our programmes.

Wollaton Park

Taking advantage of our brilliant location, we will take children out on local day trips. Middleton Primary School is based on the edge of Wollaton Hall and Deer Park, where we go to show children the incredible historical house, gardens and local wildlife. We also play games in the park!

Arts & Crafts

We get children involved with a variety of artistic methods; painting, collage, clay modelling, decoration making and sketching. There's no crafts project too big for our Play Leaders!

Swimming

We love going swimming! Every Monday, Wednesday and Friday we take a coach to The Portland Centre for our very own sessions.

Children take part in a fun swimming test at the beginning of the week, and all children are supported by our team and the pool lifeguards throughout.

STEAM

A hands-on approach

to learning using Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics.

It involves using fun, interactive projects to show children how these subjects work in the real world! The activities help to encourage creativity, imagination building, critical thinking, and teamwork.

We provide sessions and projects at both our term-time and holiday childcare clubs, giving children the chance to learn about exciting career paths while learning new skills in an interactive, practical way.

Outdoor and indoor sports

In the warmer months, we make use of the brilliant outdoor space at Middleton Primary and Nursery School, playing football, cricket, rounders and loads more outdoor sports. We also try our hand at orienteering and outdoor team building challenges.





What to bring and being prepared

Lunch, afternoon snacks and allergies

Please let us know if your child has any allergies. Your child will need a water bottle, a packed lunch and plenty of healthy snacks to keep them fuelled for the whole day. Fresh drinking water available all day. Food must be non-perishable as no refrigeration is available. Please add an icepack to your child's lunchbox, especially in summer.



What to bring

- Clothes that can get a bit messy
- Sensible shoes for running around
- Waterproofs
- Swimming kit*
- Sun cream and hat

What not to bring

Children won't need to bring toys, jewellery, electronics, phones or games to the club. There's so much to do already! Please also avoid wearing wheeled shoes or flip flops. YMCA cannot be responsible for anything lost or broken while with us.



Sun cream

If the sun comes out we'll help your child apply suncream. This will be done by a member of staff. Please let the Play Leader know if you would rather we didn't apply suncream to your child. We provide sun cream, but if your child has any allergies please ensure to pack your own.

Labelling

Please mark all personal items, including clothes and packed lunches, with your child's name. Nottinghamshire YMCA is not responsible for lost, misplaced or stolen items but we'll do our best to make sure your child leaves with everything they arrived with (apart from their lunch!).
